#### **1. GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Virtual International Programme (VIP) was launched in the winter semester of 2020/21. It provides an additional exchange opportunity for students from our partner university twice a year. The VIP includes a range of courses that are revised on a semester basis, as well as a selection of regular courses that are continuously available. VIP courses form part of JLU's curriculum, enabling JLU and international students to collaborate within a digital classroom.

Since launching in 2020, the VIP has welcomed between 350 and 500 virtual exchange students each semester. Every semester, students can choose from about 50 courses offered by all 11 faculties of JLU, available to both Bachelor's and Master's students. Recently, the course catalogue included courses taught in English, German, Spanish,

French, Portuguese, and Arabic.

In the context of remote internationalization, VIP presents an opportunity to gain an international experience from the comfort of home, with a focus on inclusivity and sustainability.

#### 3. VIP COURSE PROGRAMME

VIP offers a diverse catalogue comprising both established, regular courses and an innovative, semester-changing curriculum. Students and doctoral candidates have the option to choose up to five courses.

- REGULAR COURSES Always on offer: our regular courses are either available in the summer or winter semesters. High-quality teaching on fundamental topics.
- COURSE CATALOGUE Current Topics & New Perspectives: we offer a semester-changing course programme to give our lecturers and students the opportunity to focus on current academic, political, and economic topics and trends.
- INTERDISCIPLINARY SEMINARS organized by lecturers from different faculties. This
  provides diversity in the cultural and academic exchange. The academic dialogue and
  interactive learning help acquire intercultural and digital key competences as well as
  teamworking skills during the virtual study experience.
- INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL COLLABORATIVE TEACHING seminars offered in collaboration with universities from all over the world. Developed and taught jointly by JLU-lecturers and teachers from partner universities. Professors and lecturers coordinate their research interests, bundle their resources, and collaboratively design a seminar.

## 4. E-MENTORING TEAM & ACCOMPANYING PROGRAMME

The E-Mentors are JLU-students from different faculties who help international virtual students providing personal advice on student issues by e-mail and video call as well as tech-support.



 ONLINE ORIENTATION WEEK: At the start of each semester, JLU conducts a virtual orientation week specifically designed for international students. The sessions provide crucial information about the university's organization, as well as guidance on the IT tools and administrative systems utilized at JLU.



 ONLINE INFORMATIONAL & SOCIAL EVENTS: Throughout the semester, various online meet-ups and social gatherings are arranged to address inquiries related to academic studies at JLU and to foster connections among students. On the first and third Monday of each month, the Question Monday provides insights into topics relevant to studying at JLU. Moreover, each Wednesday we host a casual Online Get-Together, providing students with an opportunity to connect outside the academic setting. Participants can join discussions, ask questions, participate in online games, or even find a Tandem partner.
